How to set up your Director Identification Number - Foreign Directors

The following guide will help company directors apply for a unique identification number (DIN).

BEFORE YOU APPLY

- 1. Before you apply to set up your DIN, you will need the following:
 - a) Certified copies of:
 - · One primary and one secondary identity document; or
 - Two primary identity documents

Examples primary documents include:

- Foreign birth certificate
- Foreign passport
- Australian full birth certificate
- Australian passport

Examples of secondary documents include:

- National photo identification card
- Foreign government identification
- Driver's licence

b) If your identify documents are not written in English, you must arrange for them to be translated into English by an approved translation service and certified as a true and correct copy.

Translations should also be accompanied by a certified copy of the original document in the language of origin. Each translation should display an official stamp (or similar) that shows the certifier's accreditation.

TO APPLY

- 1. Download the paper form to apply: Application for a director identification number (NAT75329, PDF, 306KB)
- 2. To prevent delays in processing your application, ensure you answer all the questions using BLOCK LETTERS. Penalties apply for providing false or misleading information.
- 3. Complete Section A: Tax File Number

4. Complete **Section B: Application Requirements**

Section B: Application requirements		
You can apply for a director ID if you are: an eligible officer, or intend to become an eligible officer within 12 months after applying.		
An eligible officer, is an appointed director or alternate director (acting in that capacity) of a company, body corporate that is a registered Australian body or registered foreign company, or an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander corporation.		
The Registrar may make a determination that a particular person or class of persons are not eligible officers.		
You should not apply for a director ID if you already have an active director ID, unless you have been directed to by the Registrar.		
I am an eligible officer or intend to become an eligible officer within 12 months of my application		
To be eligible to be a director, you must: be an individual, be at least 18 years of age; and not be disqualified from managing corporations unless your appointment is made with the permission of ASIC, ORIC, or with leave of the Court.		
I acknowledge to be a director I must meet the requirements of the Corporations Act 2001 and/or the Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006		
If you have previously applied for and been issued a director ID, and have been asked by the Registrar to reapply, enter your previously issued director ID here and continue to the next section.
